Niigata - Ryotsu

Table with columns: Period, Niigata - Ryotsu, Ryotsu - Niigata. Rows include dates from Mar. 23 to Apr. 17, Apr. 18 to Apr. 26, Apr. 27 to May 6, and May 7 to Aug. 6.

Table with columns: Period, Niigata - Ryotsu, Ryotsu - Niigata. Rows include dates from Aug. 10 to Aug. 18, Aug. 19 to Oct. 14, Oct. 15 to Oct. 27, and Oct. 28 to Nov. 1.

Table with columns: Period, Niigata - Ryotsu, Ryotsu - Niigata. Rows include dates from Nov. 2 to Nov. 16, Nov. 17 to Nov. 23, Nov. 24 to Dec. 31.

Naoetsu - Ogi

Table with columns: Period, Naoetsu - Ogi, Ogi - Naoetsu. Rows include dates from Mar. 1 to Nov. 15, Nov. 16 to Dec. 29, and Nov. 30 to Dec. 31.

Fixed-route Bus Schedules

Please have small change or a 1,000 yen bill ready before getting on the bus. The fare machine and bus driver cannot accept large bills such as 10,000 yen, 5,000 yen and 2,000 yen. Our driver may not be able to speak English. Thank you.

*Most buses display a sign on the LED destination board (or behind the windshield) indicating its line number with a capital letter of the destination for which the bus is bound. (e.g. 2S means the bus is bound for Sawata on Line #2, Minamisen Line.) However, this may not apply when weekend services extend beyond the destination of the original route. Each may display its original route's destination only. Bus time may vary depending on traffic conditions.

7 Maehama Line (Hamochi High School <-----> Oda) Table with routes H and O, stop names, and bus times.
